

## **ABOUT US**

USC Dance Marathon (USCDM) is the largest student-run philanthropic organization in the state of South Carolina that benefits Prisma Health Children's Hospital in the Midlands. Last year, for our 26th year, over 1,600 participants came together to raise \$715,107 for the miracle kids. Since our inception in 1998, USC Dance Marathon has raised over \$9 million.

Our funds support Prisma Health Children's Hospital in the Midlands, a member of Children's Miracle Network (CMN) Hospitals. It is South Carolina's largest freestanding children's hospital that serves over 15,000 children. USCDM supports the hospital's initiatives such as their Child Life Program, treatment education, and consistent support to the children and their families. In the past, USCDM has funded projects such as the hospital's new facility dogs and the building of "The USC Dance Marathon Playground" that provides a safe outdoor space for patients and sibilings to play during their hospital stay.

USC Dance Marathon's year-long fundraising effort consists of many events, all dedicated to raising funds and awareness for the children at Prisma Health Children's Hospital in the Midlands. Our organization works with the Columbia community to share the cause, and we assist local schools to lead their own Mini Marathons. In the spring, USCDM holds a 14-hour Main Event that is a celebration of our hard work and our biggest fundraising day of the year. Main Event highlights everyone who made the year possible, such as our miracle families, Mini Marathons, and our sponsors. We conclude the event with a final flip, revealing the year's fundraising total.
